It is true, there is no place like home. But when you have no home to go to it is good to know that there are organizations and places that you can turn to that will lend a hand. Shelterbox USA is one of those organizations. Its mission is simple: *To provide humanitarian aid worldwide in the form of shelter, warmth and dignity to people displaced by natural and other disasters.*"

On last week we had the opportunity to here from John Freeman, a fellow Rotarian (*Member of the Rotary Club of*

*Lakewood Ranch*) and Shelterbox volunteer.

A Shelterbox is exactly what its name says it is. A box (*a tough, green plastic box*) containing a tent (*Shelter*) and ancillary equipment designed to enable a family of up to 10 people survive for at least six months.

In times of disaster, many thousands of people are often left homeless and without basic shelter and survival equipment. Shelterbox stands ready to provide aid to those in need anywhere in the world. Each Shelter Box provides a dry shelter, warm bed, light and heat, clean water, cooking aids and tools for 10 people.

ShelterBox USA works directly with local organizations in countries where disasters have occurred, and in partnership with other aid agencies and

through the international Rotary network.

A few of the places that Shelterboxes have been deployed included: *Papua New Guinea, Somalia, Brazil, Cuba, Honduras, the Congo, Kyrgyzstan, Nepal, Swaziland, Haiti and Turks & Caicos.* Shelterboxes were used in *the Pakistan Earthquake, the Ukraine Flooding and the China Earthquake*
