On last week in Rotary we had the privilege of hearing from one of Sarasota's local legends. While many may not think of him as such, that in fact, is exactly what **Bob Johnson, Former Senator** has been. He has been a champion and advocate for many of the non-profit organizations and local treasures here in our city (*New College, the Ringling Museum, South Lido Park, to name a few*).

Bob has been around long enough to fill us in on some of the rich heritage that exists right here in our own backyard. Can you name the current golf course that used to be home to a wine valley? Better still, did you know that there

was once a wine valley in Sarasota? Did you know that the state's top honor college -- home to 30 Fulbright scholars, as well as the alma mater of some of this nation's top scholars was founded by the Congregational Christian Church? If you knew the answers to these questions you could have walked away last week with a couple of bottles of vintage wine.

During the recession (*not the current one*) Senator Johnson was instrumental in developing legislation that secured New College's future as the states eleventh University. He helped to rescue this educational landmark from Bankruptcy.

Senator Johnson, a product of the depression era did not allow his humble beginnings to limit his ability to rise. He has been the recipient of the Distinguished Alumnus Award, *University of Florida*; The E.T. York Medal for Service to the

State University System; and The Westcott Medal for Lifetime Service. He was a member of the Florida House of Representatives from 1970 to 1976, and again from 1982 to 1984. He was a member of the Florida Senate from 1984 to 1992.

Senator Johnson served on the Governor's Committees on: Capital Punishment; Property rights and Education. His life of public service has included serving as Chairman to the Florida Arts Council and Director of the New College Foundation, inc.

His awards are numerous, his service to this community remarkable, his dedication to the betterment of arts and education commendable. He has and will continue to be a champion for human rights and social justice.

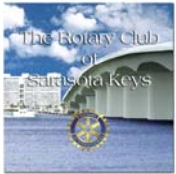
