On last week members of the Sarasota Keys Rotary Club had the opportunity to hear from Eva Slane, a community activist with a heart and passion for the theatre. When the war broke out in 1939 Eva came to America from Europe. She grew up in Manhattan, and attended Hunter College.

As an Equity licensed Theatrical Agent, Eva has had the privilege of working with some of the industries top performers, Helen Hayes, James Earl Jones, Martha Graham, Horton Foote, Lillian Gish, and

Carl Sandburg to name a few. Later marrying producer Stephan Slane, they moved to Beverly, Massachusetts and she went to work at her husband's non-profit company, North Shore Music Theatre.

The NSMT is now 53 years old and continues to thrive. Sarasota has been home to Eva since 1991.

Eva currently serves on Boards at the ASOLO Repertoire Theatre; The BANYAN Theatre and the Manatee Players. She is following her passion for theater and our community is fortunate to have her in its midst.

In 2005 Eva was invited by the Florida Holocaust Museum in St. Petersburg to participate in a writing project which resulted in its publication in March of last year. **We Were There. . . Memories of the Holocaust.** Based on one

of her essays from this project she wrote the 1-Minute play "This I Remember." She later expanded the play to 10-Minutes, renaming it "Forgotten Memories" and entered into the Odyssey Theatre 2008 Competition. It won Honorable Mention.

Eva presented some of her works from Theater Memories which were written as part of the Museum Project.

Eva without a doubt, is passionate about the arts. When not out front you can see her in the front row of most of the theatres around town.

Thank you Liliane for bringing Eva to our club and giving us the opportunity to hear and learn from her many vast experiences. As an enthusiastic supporter of the theater, Eva has quickly become one of Sarasota's living treasures.
