fantastic, the food excellent and the fellowship wonderful. We enjoyed it all while being serenaded by Mona Gordon on the piano.

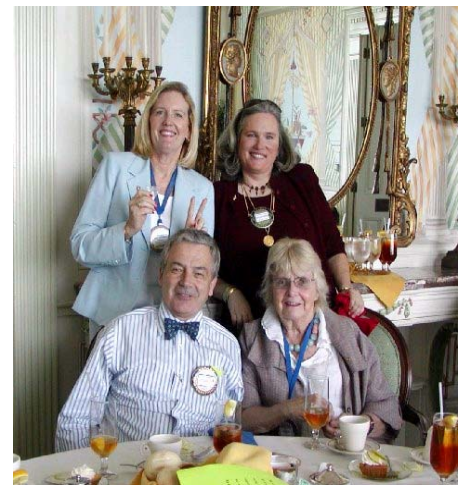
