Their mission is noble and their task is great. But for each family they help to get back on their feet their reward is priceless. Lending a helping hand is easier than you think. Family promise is part of a nationwide network of over 125 affiliates that touch the lives of over 20,000 homeless family members (*most of them children*) each year.


