Sign up now and let him know where you intend to serve.

#### Set-up and Break-down

**Committee:** Teams are responsible for ensuring the event's portable equipment is set up in accordance with the predetermined site position plan. They help with assembly, if needed. Following the event's end, they ensure all disassembly and removal of items is accomplished within the allocated hour.

#### Site Planning

**Committee:** Members decide where participants' booths,

refuse containers, first aid station(s), ticket sales booths, electrical needs, port-o-let positioning, operations site location,

#### Financial Committee:

Event's ticket sales people and bank run personnel. Team members will keep track of how many tickets are sold compared to how much money is collected.

#### Publicity Committee:

Duties are to "wordsmith" effective reasons why our event is THE EVENT to join and participate in. They will disseminate to all print and broadcast media outlets.

#### Participation

**Solicitation Committee:** This team needs to conduct targeting research, organize solicitation methods and plan team's timelines and schedule vender meetings.

#### Oversight Management

**Committee:** Maintains overall management of the event during its planning, set-up, implementation, clean-up and follow-on requirements. Oversees permitting requirements.

#### Website Designer/

**Webmaster:** Designs and implements a showcase website for the event, expeditiously adds participants' information when received, and maintains continuing currency of website.

#### Historian:

Keeps a permanent record of event's

planning and permitting requirements and results, key contact information, timelines, successes and recommended improvements for follow-on events, etc.

#### security Committee:

This team reviews security and safety procedures with law enforcement personnel and coordinates with the various teams to ensure maximum safety and security of event's attendees, participants, assets, and related items.

#### Refuse Committee:

This team will ensure all refuse is collected throughout the grounds during the event and deposited into the appropriate trash barrels.

#### Entertainment

**Committee:** This team will rent the county's "Show Mobile". They will coordinate with the Planning Committee on its positioning and use. They will obtain suitable entertainment for the 5 hour event. They will also organize the Waiters' Race.

#### Insurance Committee:

This team will solicit quotes from AM Best rated Excellent (or above) insurance companies for our event and its permitting requirements.

#### Alcohol Licensing

**Committee:** This team will determine the requirements for and obtain an event alcohol license.
