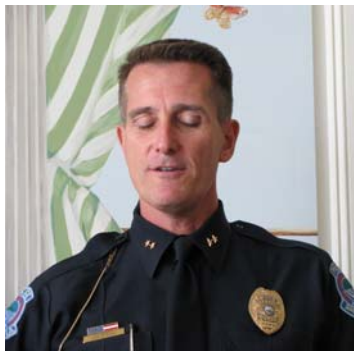

You would be hard pressed to find an adult who could not tell you their whereabouts when that first airplane hit the World Trade Center. It did not take long to discover that this was no accident, but a carefully crafted attack on the United States.

The course of what started out to be a beautiful sunny day was permanently altered by a senseless act of terrorism. Life in the United States as we know it changed. In the face of this cataclysmic tragedy, our nation collectively experienced a plethora of emotions that spanned from grief to pain, from fear and uncertainty to anger and disbelief.

On last week, we had to opportunity to hear a first-hand account of that day's events from Police



Chief Peter Abbott. At that time, he was a high ranking officer in the New York Police Department, stationed in lower Manhattan — *walking distance to the towers.*

Chief Abbott reminded us of the selfless nature of the police officers and firefighters who, armed with a sense of duty to defend and protect, went into these burning buildings. To many of us these were police officers carrying out their duty. To Chief Abbott, they were friends and colleagues. We will never forget the tragedy of that day. As we reflect on it, we will also reflect on the courage and bravery that our civil servants displayed in the face of danger. We will remember those who sacrificed their lives to protect others. We will



remember and applaud the exemplary leadership that our officers utilized to bring order, peace and civility to a state under attack. If you were to ask Chief Abbott, he would humbly say, he was just doing his job. But, as we, the residents of Sarasota County can attest, it is because of his decisive leadership, calm and reassuring temperament that we can rest safe at night knowing that our liberty is protected by the men that are under his command. *Thank you Chief Abbott for all that you do.*
