John Pether, a native New Zealander and Board of trustee member for Mote Marine Laboratory gave an overview of some of the fascinating research that is going on in Mote's Marine's Aqua park.

The United States seafood trade deficit is almost 8 billion dollars per year. This national trade deficit is second only to oil. Government statistics project that the seafood demand in the United States will continue to increase

over the coming decades. Given that the oceans have reached their maximum sustainable yield, the increased seafood demand can only be satisfied by aquaculture production.

To help meet the needs that this demand will bring, Mote Marine's Aquaculture Program dedicates its work to developing the technologies needed to raise fish species with high market value and/or high recreational demand.

The park, located in the eastern part of Sarasota County has quickly become one of the States top research centers in aquaculture. The center is currently conducting research, development and commercial

demonstration projects with a number of marine and freshwater species.

One program that has proven its ability to be cost effective is its Siberian Sturgeon project. This project began producing meat in 2004 and caviar in 2006. Yes, we are raising Siberian Sturgeon right here in Sarasota!

The Water filtration system used and developed at the Aqua park has proven to be cost effective and environmentally friendly. Mote continues to remain on the cutting edge of aquatic research.
